NEWS FROM THE NURSE'S OFFICE

1. Botelle School is still following the Test, Mask, Go Protocol and there have been no changes to this protocol. Please continue to utilize the Covid-19 Symptoms Decision Tree and resources that were sent home at the beginning of the year. This information can also be found on the school website under the Health/Safety tab. Thank you for your continued communication with the Health Office and sending negative Covid test results via email.

2. Please know we do go outside for recess as long as the temperature is 20 degrees or higher including the wind chill. Please send your children to school with full snow gear (hats, gloves, coats, snow pants, and boots). It is required in order to play in the snow and it also keeps them warm in the freezing temperatures.

3. Things to come..... Please know that a letter and Covid-19 home test kits will be sent home with children before the winter break. This is to ensure everyone has a test available to them if needed over the holiday break. If you would prefer your child/children's test kits are not sent home via backpack mail.
