

Student-Staff Symptoms of COVID-19 in School

SCHOOL NURSE SCREENING

- Potential COVID exposure
- Other considerations
 - Existing conditions
 - Medication
 - History of symptoms

SEND HOME – ENCOURAGE TESTING

NO TEST

ASSUME + COVID-19

POSITIVE TEST

NEGATIVE TEST

RETURN TO SCHOOL AFTER CDC CLEARANCE CRITERIA MET

- 24 hrs fever free
- NO fever reducing medications
- Symptoms improved
- At least 10 days from onset of symptoms

DOCTOR NOTE
For clearance

RETURN TO SCHOOL

- Symptoms improved
- Doctor clearance met
- School guidelines met

STUDENT/STAFF REMAIN HOME until CDC Clearance Criteria MET

- 24 hrs fever free
- NO fever reducing medications
- Symptoms improved
- At least 10 days from onset of symptoms
- Doctor note

CONTACT TRACING INITIATED

Identification of close contacts 48 hrs prior to onset of symptoms

14 DAY QUARANTINE of close contacts

Torrington Health Department to monitor

RETURN TO SCHOOL

- Symptoms improved
- Doctor clearance met
- School guidelines met

RETURN TO SCHOOL

- Symptoms improved
- Doctor clearance met
- School guidelines met

*When community positivity rates are low, likelihood of symptoms being COVID is reduced. Screening guidelines may change if positivity rates
